Indore is considered as business hub and industrial capital of Madhya Pradesh. It is also known as Mini Mumbai. Many people migrate to Indore city for viable livelihood & for better earning with their family.

Based upon our observation we have concluded that, Indore has comparatively good wages too. All these circumstance pushes many children to work willingly or unwillingly and forced to earn with their rest of family members, which could increase gross family income.

The actual need is to see that such children should avail better educational facility, which includes (formal & Informal) education and should not force into hazardous occupations.

The concern should be drawn from the children who are well off and studying in premier schools of the city. It is expected from them to help to those who are marginalized and belongs to underprivileged category.

It is also expected to ripe the social responsibility among the children so that they can feel that there is somebody who is being helped by them. Which will grow as a emotional bonding in future.

The objectives has been formed in such a way which will also cover the sustainability of activities in form of proving them the economic self sufficiency, long term rehabilitation and linkages with the resource organizations.

Indeed community & voluntary participation has been covered which will give more qualitative input to both i.e beneficiaries and parents.
